Planning to go to Andorra soon? You definitely should. Take your European Youth Card along and you will spend less and experience more of Andorra's world-famous ski slopes, spas and breathtaking landscape.

Read on to check out our selection of the very best discounts for visitors!



Getting there

The best way to get to Andorra is to fly to near-by airports like Barcelona, Toulouse or Girona and then hop on a bus. The great news is that you have 10% off your airport transfer to Andorra! Plus, if you want to rent a car during your stay, you can use your card to get 15% off.

Accommodation

Stay close to the slopes with these great accommodation discounts! You have 15% off accommodation and meals at the <u>Hotel Diplomatic</u>, not to mention discounts of at least 10% in other <u>45 hotels in the country!</u>

If you want to be at the very heart of the action, choose the Mountain Hostel El Tarter, which is located right in front one of the main entrances to the Grandvalira ski resort - you have 10% off accommodation. You get the same discount at Hostel La Comella, another nature retreat close to the capital Andorra la Vella.



Winter fun

Now that you've arrived and you're settled in, let the fun begin! You have 10% off a ski pass for two or more days at the Vallnord ski and adventure resort. You also get a 10% discount on guided hiking trips and mountain climbing at Ensangents Aventures. For even more fun, check out the Roc Roi adventure park - you get 30% off all winter activities!

If you don't make it to Andorra in winter, don't worry - there are plenty of fun things to do in summer as well. For example, you can check out the Tobotronc - the longest alpine slide in natural surroundings in the world, a 5.3 km long sled ride through the woods. You have 10% off on the Tobotronc and all other summer and winter activities at the Naturlandia resort!

Sport & spa

If you prefer some indoor activity there is plenty to choose from. You have <u>up to 50% off</u> in several sports centres with swimming pools, ice-skating rings and even <u>paintball</u>. Plus you can always take your friends and go to a basketball game - <u>you have a 25% discount on tickets!</u>

When you feel like you want to relax and indulge, head over to the <u>Caldea Inuu spa</u> - Andorra's largest spa centre. The 12% discount on the entrance ticket and all treatments are going to help you relax even more. You also have <u>10% off spa services</u> at the Hotel Roc Blanc, right in the heart of the main shopping district in Andorra.

Culture

Take a break from the slopes and don't miss Andorra's cultural side!

Learn a bit about traditional life on this side of the Pyrenees by visiting two amazing historical houses - <u>Casa Rull</u> and <u>Casa Areny Plandolit</u>. Take your card along and you get in for free!

If you're into cars and motorcycles you can't miss the <u>Museu National de l'Automobil</u> (free entrance with your card) and <u>Museu de la Moto</u> (50% off). You also have free entrance at the <u>Perfume Museum</u> where you can explore the history of perfumes and scents.

Finally, your cultural tour can't miss the <u>Siadristy Miniature Museum</u>. It displays the works of Nikolaï Siadristy, the best micro miniaturist in the world. Plus, you have 50% off your ticket here.

Eating out

Have fun and great meals out on a budget! You have special deals and discounts in 23 restaurants across the country. To experience great local cuisine, check out our selection of restaurants here. If you happen to feel like sushi, Mexican food or simply want to have a quick bite to eat, you're also covered - see your options here.

After dinner, you can take your friends to have a drink together at the <u>Temple Bar</u>. You get 10% off your bill and get to hear some great live music.
