

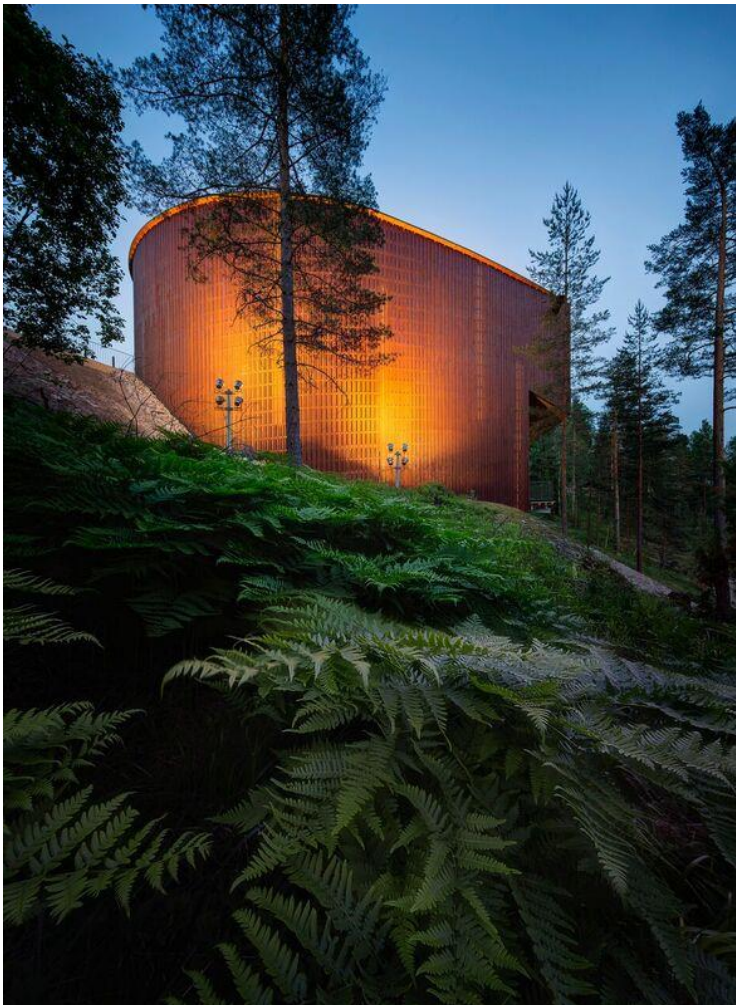
Ruohonjuuri
